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Description

Anda is a small town at the furthest south-east tip of Bohol. It has the nicest beach in all of Bohol and one of the nicest in all of the Philippines with the bonus of a free freshwater shower and clean WC right on the beach. The Municipality of Anda is committed to develop a well-balanced economy, social and spiritual, infrastructure, good governance and environment to bolster eco-cultural tourism without compromising the welfare of the people, their culture and resources.

Lamanoc Island is at the eastern-most cape of Bohol island and has limestone rocks, caves, and its own tiny and secluded white-sand beaches. There's a very long bamboo pier, that leads through a large mangrove forest to a waiting shed on stilts. Feed the local monkeys while you wait for a small banca. Medicine men (*baylan* or *tambalan*) officiated at the interment of wooden lungon or boat coffins (so called because they were made from a dug-out log, similar to the way boats were made) and old earthenware jars. You can still see finger paintings using haematite (red iron oxide) pigments in some of the caves.
